2025 LIHHS Highlights

- More than **1,100 hours of volunteer visits** to Lopezians
- Over **250 pieces of durable medical equipment**—walkers, canes, wheelchairs, shower chairs—loaned free of charge to residents recovering from injury or illness
- **Six small safety grants awarded**, totaling nearly \$7,000, helping community members stay safely in their homes
- **More than 60 participants** took part in *Balance is Your Friend*, our Living Well on Lopez workshop offered in collaboration with Lopez EMS, Lopez Physical Therapy, and Lopez Fit
- **Three new Lopez Fit machines** purchased in consultation with Lopez Physical Therapy, made possible by generous donors to LIHHS's 2025 Give Lopez campaign (\$16,550 raised!)

Throughout the year, LIHHS has collaborated closely with **Lopez Island EMS, Lopez Physical Therapy, Lopez Fit, Creaky Yoga, the Senior Center, and Hamlet House & Cottages** — all working together to support safety, connection, and quality of life for our neighbors.
